The third edition of the "Security and Defense Days", the annual conference promoted by the De Gasperi Foundation, will take place in Rome on 17-18 October 2023, at the Palace of the Lombardy Region (via del Gesù 57).

The event is co-organized with the Wilfried Martens Centre for European Studies, in cooperation with the NATO Public Diplomacy Division, and comes at a particularly delicate time for the international scenario, with the Russian aggression against Ukraine threatening the security of the entire West, an increasingly assertive China, and a strongly evolving Indo-Pacific region.

The proceedings will develop over two days and will consist of four thematic sessions, bringing together personalities from institutions and the political world, diplomats and military officers, experts and media representatives, who will share their insights and reflections on the following issues:

- NATO's role and strategic perspectives after the Vilnius Summit;
- The importance of developing the European defense industry, and the complementarity between NATO and the EU in the field of security and defense;
- The growing challenges for the EU in the fields of technology and energy;
- The impact of the Russian aggression against Ukraine on the countries of the EU's eastern neighborhood.

NATO's strategic prospects after the Vilnius Summit: new balances between eastern flank, southern flank, and the global geo-strategic framework

The session aims to examine the decisions taken by the Atlantic Alliance at the Summit held last July in Vilnius. On this occasion, the Heads of State and Government broadly reaffirmed the directions outlined in the Strategic Concept approved in Madrid in 2022, amidst persistent and serious instability on the eastern flank, coupled with increasingly significant interconnections with the Russian and Chinese presence in the southern flank and Africa.
